COMPOSITION & ACCOMODATION

Although, Frontline Response is unable to offer paid internships at this time, room and board is available at the low cost of \$400 per month in downtown Atlanta. Lodging is only 9 miles from Frontline Response headquarters.

During the months of June and July room and board are available at no charge.

For individuals seeking internship opportunities for educational requirements Frontline Response is able to accommodate such requirements on a case by case basis.

KEY DETAILS

- Duration of internships are available anywhere from two weeks to one year
- A minimum of 25 hours per week
- Opportunity to work in field/department of choice
- Flexible schedule that allows for free time during the week if intern wishes to acquire a part-time job

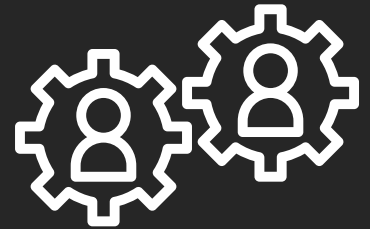
